Approval of minutes for the June 30, 2017 meeting. The minutes for the previous committee meeting were approved by consensus.

Staff Report. Appreciation was given for the open discourse and all parties participation. There was nothing to report since the prior week's meeting.

General Discussion:

The Statewide Juvenile Justice Improvement Initiative, Council of State Governments Justice Center Staff gave a presentation on their work in New Mexico.

They work to involve all three branches of government in a non-partisan manner as to improve juvenile justice. The process involving three phases. First, they collect and analyze quantitative data. Second, they review policy and practice. Third, they present system improvement recommendations and new policies to adopt.

Currently the organization is creating detailed data analysis and will soon be doing final analysis on the data collected. The organization also expressed issues in the data of tracking of Native American juveniles. The goal is to have their analysis ready for 2018 legislation.

The committee thanked the organization for their time and may schedule follow up conversations in the future as to improve outcomes and foster legislative action.
