

Crime Reduction Grants Awarded for FY2021

Court Services

2nd JD: Incentives for Treatment Court

Provides funding to the BCMC to purchase incentives for clients enrolled in the treatment courts and for toiletries and food items for clients who have completed the Outreach Court Program.

8th JD: Computers and Monitoring Equipment for Drug Treatment

Provides funding for equipment to facilitate electronic monitoring through ankle monitors equipped with GPS and/or SCRAM units that detect alcohol consumption for clients of the Taos Adult Drug Court and the Raton Adult Drug Court. Also used to purchase laptops, peripheral devices, cell phones, tablets, data cards, phone cards, and hotspots for internet connectivity.

Pretrial

3rd JD: Equipment for New Pretrial Services Department

Provides funding to successfully implement a critically needed Pretrial Services program at the Third Judicial District Court with the necessary tools such as testing supplies and office related supplies to begin operating.

13th JD: Pretrial Monitoring Equipment

Provides funding for the purchase of additional monitoring (GPS and SCRAM) equipment to allow for more pretrial options for judges, prosecutors, and defense attorneys.

Recruitment and Retention of Staff

2nd JD: Case Manager for Special Courts

Provides funding to hire and train a Case Manager to work exclusively with the clients of the Competency Court, the Behavioral Health Court and the DWI Behavioral Health Court.
