

Crime Reduction Grants Awarded for FY2022

Court Services

4th JD: Drug Court Program and San Miguel County Sobriety Court

Provides funding to start a community garden program, an exercise program, and provide for additional incentives and monitoring for participants in the Fourth Judicial District's drug and DWI court.

8th JD: Family Violence (FV) Treatment Court

Provides funding for the FV Treatment Court, which connects individuals charged and/or convicted of FV offenses to therapeutic services, including Batterer's Intervention groups, case management, and substance use disorder treatment.

Pretrial

13th JD: Pretrial Monitoring Equipment

Provides funding for the purchase of additional monitoring (GPS and SCRAM) equipment to allow for more pretrial options for judges, prosecutors, and defense attorneys.

Recruitment and Retention of Staff

2nd JD: Case Manager for Special Courts

Provides funding to maintain the existing position for the Program Project Coordinator to work exclusively with the clients of the Competency Court within the Behavioral Health unit, and work closely with the Forensic Navigation Pilot Program.
