

Crime Reduction Grants Awarded for FY2024, Including Round 2 Awards

Court Services

2nd JD: Mental Health Court Program

Provides funding for a pre- and post-plea diversion treatment court program that is designed specifically for individuals whose involvement with the justice system is directly related to an untreated or un-stabilized mental health disorder.

2nd JD: Lease of Remote Alcohol Monitoring Devices

Provides funding for the Bernalillo County Metropolitan Court to lease Remote Alcohol Monitoring Devices (SCRAM/CAM) and use a Transdermal 24/7 alcohol monitoring agency for these devices.

2nd JD: Alternative Treatment Enhancement Services

Provides funding for the Bernalillo County Metropolitan Court to contract with community treatment providers for alternative enhancement treatment options for the participants of its Specialty Court Programs.

2nd JD: Buffalo, NY, Opioid Court Site Visit

Provides funding for members of the Bernalillo County Metropolitan Court staff to visit the Opioid Intervention Court (OIC) in Buffalo, NY, to observe and learn how to implement and sustain an OIC program.

3rd JD: District Court Treatment Programs

Provides funding for specialty programs that handle cases involving offenders who suffer from mental health disorders, substance dependence, and possess high prognostic risk and criminogenic needs.

4th JD: Behavioral Health Court and Healthcare Manager

Provides funding to establish a behavioral health specialty court program under the auspices of the Fourth Judicial District Court with the assistance of contracted service providers, as well as to improve the District's two existing addiction treatment courts.

4th JD: San Miguel County Magistrate DWI Court Bicycles and Hygiene Closet

Provides funding for a Hygiene Closet and bike program for DWI Treatment Court participants.

4th JD: Animal Abuse Training & Awareness Project

Provides funding to train law enforcement officers and animal control officers and shelter staff to identify and document criminal activity in various contexts.

5th JD: Chaves Adult Treatment Court Program

Provides funding for the Chaves County Adult Treatment Court Program to provide incentives as a reward for the participants to assist them becoming more engaged in the program requirements and in turn provide better outcomes within their individual and social environments.

6th JD: Day Habilitation Support Services

Provides funding to support enhanced Day Habilitation services for drug court clients with substance use disorders and/or mental health disorders who commit low level or petty misdemeanor offenses.

8th JD: Family Violence (FV) Treatment Court

Provides funding to continue the existing FV Treatment Court, which connects individuals charged and/or convicted of FV offenses to therapeutic services, including Batterer's Intervention groups, case management, and substance use disorder treatment.

11th JD: Alumni and Peer Support for Adult Problem-Solving Court Programs

Provides funding for expanding the Alumni Support and Peer Support Program for the Adult Drug Court, Mental Health Court, and DWI Court.

12th JD: Young Adult Court

Provides funding for treatment and social services for individuals aged 18 to 25 who have pending felony charges at the Twelfth District Court.

Diversion

2nd JD: Diversion Program of the District Attorney's Office

Provides funding for removing low level offenders from the criminal justice system and placing them into treatment and rehabilitation services through the DA's Pre-Prosecution Diversion (PPD) program or Specialty Courts.

2nd JD: Gun Violence Prevention and Reduction Program of the District Attorney's Office

Provides funding for the DA's office to develop and run a diversion program for non-violent gun-related offenses and implement intervention tactics to reduce and prevent gun violence, increase public safety, and reduce recidivism.

3rd JD: Doña Ana County Data-Driven Justice Initiative, Part II

Provides funding for the County to work in collaboration with researchers at New Mexico State University to develop data-driven criminal justice response and intervention systems for adults with either serious mental illness or co-occurring substance use disorders.

6th JD: Veteran's Diversion Program

Provides funding for the development and implementation of a Pre-Prosecution Diversion Program for Veterans.

13th JD: Resource Assessment Center

Provides funding for a Resource Assessment Center for those 18 and older who have had police contact or are considered at-risk of police contact. The Center is focused on decreasing contact with law enforcement by assessing clients' needs and strengths and providing case management services.

Pretrial

1st JD: Bus Passes for Pretrial Services

Provides funding to allow Pretrial Services the ability to provide all individuals ordered to be under their supervision the ability to obtain a free monthly bus pass through their Pretrial Services Officer.

1st JD: Pretrial Peer Support

Provides funding to hire a certified peer support worker to assist individuals charged with a criminal offense in the district court in complying with conditions of release.

2nd JD: Resource Reentry Center LOPD Staffing

Provides funding to staff a Resource Reentry Center as a first stop for individuals who are released from custody where they have access to case management, transition plans, and transportation.

4th JD: Pretrial Release Support

Provides funding to continue providing Global Positioning Services (GPS) equipment at no cost to defendants released on Pretrial Services.

5th JD: Transportation for Criminal Defendants

Provides funding for transportation for pretrial defendants who lack transportation to ensure that they can appear for court and pretrial appointments and remain in compliance with their conditions of release.

11th JD: San Juan County Pretrial Transportation Services

Provides funding for bus passes for pretrial defendants who lack transportation to ensure that they can appear for court and pretrial appointments and remain in compliance with their conditions of release.

11th JD: McKinley County Pretrial Transportation Services

Provides funding for bus passes for pretrial defendants who lack transportation to ensure that they can appear for court and pretrial appointments and remain in compliance with their conditions of release.

Recruitment and Retention of Staff

1st JD: CJCC Director

Provides funding to hire a Criminal Justice Coordinating Council Director to serve the First Judicial District CJCC.

2nd JD: DA & LOPD Recruitment & Retention

Provides funding for recruitment and retention bonuses for attorneys employed by the District Attorney or the Law Offices of the Public Defender with the goal of keeping both offices fully staffed so that cases can be adjudicated in a timely manner.

5th JD: LOPD Recruitment

Provides funding for recruitment bonuses for attorneys hired by the Law Offices of the Public Defender with the goal of fully staffing that office so that cases can be adjudicated in a timely manner.

9th JD: LOPD Recruitment

Provides funding for recruitment bonuses for attorneys hired by the Law Offices of the Public Defender with the goal of fully staffing that office so that cases can be adjudicated in a timely manner.

12th JD: DA & LOPD Recruitment & Retention

Provides funding for recruitment and retention bonuses for attorneys employed by the District Attorney or the Law Offices of the Public Defender with the goal of keeping both offices fully staffed so that cases can be adjudicated in a timely manner.

Crisis Intervention Teams

2nd JD: Mental Health First Aid Training

Provides funding to offer Mental Health First Aid Training to staff and attorneys of the LOPD who frequently have to respond to immediate and urgent crisis situations for clients.

2nd JD: BCSO Community Assistance and Support Team

Provides funding for Bernalillo County Sheriff's Office to create a Community Assistance and Supports Team (CAST) that will expand its social work and victim advocacy efforts.

Digitizing Records and Data Sharing

8th JD: Justice Premier

Provides funding to purchase a new platform for discovery retention and distribution across agencies (law enforcement, public defenders, court, DAs office), as well as for training on the implementation of the program.

11th JD: McKinley County Pretrial Data System

Provides funding to update and modernize the McKinley County Detention Center's data management system.

Reentry Services

2nd JD: Housing Vouchers

Provides funding for housing vouchers for adult students of the Gordon Bernell Charter School who are being released from the Metropolitan Detention Center and who comply with program requirements.

8th JD: Krossroads Training, Equipment, and Coordinator

Provides funding for staff training and the purchase of basic vital signs equipment, as well as to hire a Pretrial Services and Transitional Housing Coordinator.
